Key Responsibilities

- **Direction:** Technical direction of a professional multi-camera live stream for two main showcase events.
- **Technical Setup:** Provision and management of all necessary broadcast equipment, including cameras, vision mixers, and audio interfaces.
- **Platform Management:** Ensuring a stable stream to designated platforms (e.g., YouTube, Facebook, or a dedicated project portal).
- **Archive:** Providing a high-definition recording of the broadcast for use in the project's digital educational pack.

Technical Proposal & Equipment:

- **Multi-Destination Streaming:** The team must have the capability to stream simultaneously to multiple social media platforms (e.g., YouTube, Facebook, and/or project websites). Please specify your capacity for multi-casting.
- **Scalability:** Outline how your technical setup ensures a high-quality experience for a large-scale global audience as we aim to maximise audience reach.
- **Redundancy:** Include a plan for backup internet/failover to ensure no interruption during the live broadcast.

- **Professional fees** for the Live Stream Director and technical crew.
- **Equipment rental** (cameras, lighting for broadcast, encoders).
- **Travel and subsistence** for the team between Sligo and Derry.
- **Post-production** for a "clean" archive version of the performance.

Quotations will be assessed based on technical capacity, experience with live arts broadcasts, and value for money.
